Content Objective Questions:

- What are direct object pronouns and how do I use them?

Inquiry Questions:

Factual: What vocabulary will help me create a message about my personal expression of style?

Conceptual: How can I characterize the connections I feel with other people when I see certain styles of clothing?

Debatable: Could the connections and messages I am trying to make with different audiences be misinterpreted by certain clothing choices?
